

THE CASE AGAINST SUSAN COLLINS

ENVIRONMENT

- The League of Conservation Voters gave Collins a disappointing score of 21% for her environmental record in 2018.¹
- Collins voted to open the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge to drilling in 2017.²
- Collins repeatedly voted in support of the Keystone XL Tar Sands Pipeline between 2013 and 2015.³
- Collins received more campaign donations from oil and gas corporations in Texas than from Maine residents in the first quarter of 2019.⁴
- Almost all environmental-related Trump administration nominees approved by Collins are climate change deniers and many are former lobbyists for the fossil fuel industry.⁵
